## What is a Program Aide?

A Program Aide is:

A Specialist	She uses her talents and skills to lead other girls in learning (for example, crafts, songs, games, fire building, knot tying, engineering, science, and more).
A service-minded Girl Scout	She wants to be a REAL benefit to her unit.
A “camper” at heart	She wants to have fun too.
A teenager	She wants to have free time with girls her own age.
An example	She is a role model; her actions speak louder than words.
A researcher	She can find answers and the resources to teach anything.
A leader	She is capable of independent action when leading others
A Program Aide isn't...	but:
An errand girl	She may accompany girl messengers when necessary.
An adult	She is capable and efficient, but she cannot count as Safety-Wise ratio as an adult!
A clean-up person	She can supervise other girls doing capers.
A baby-sitter	She can plan activities to entertain girls.
A pack horse	She can carry her own equipment.
A climbing structure	She can give as many hugs as she likes.
